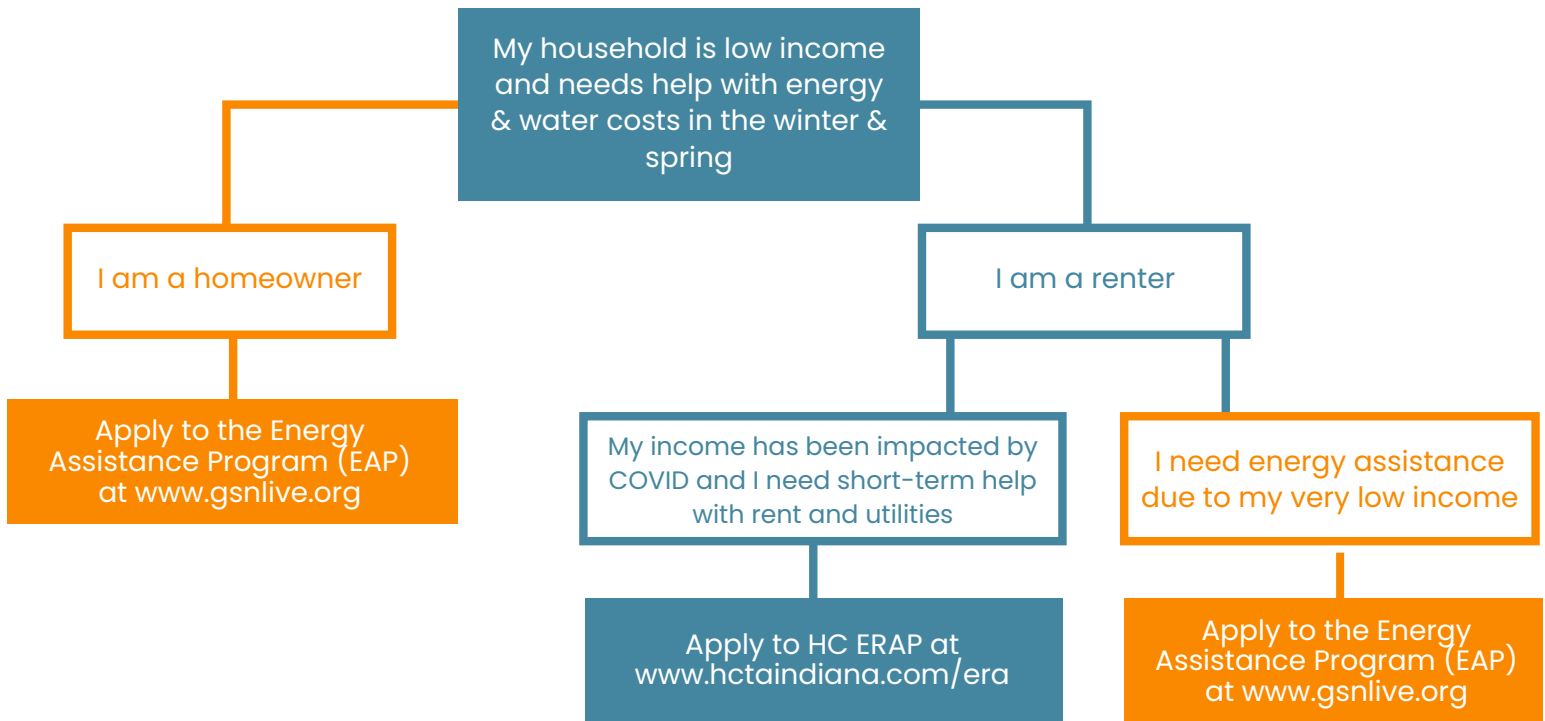

## WHERE DO I GO FOR HELP?

There are two primary programs to help households with the energy and water bills in 2022. The EAP (Energy Assistance Program) and HC ERAP (Hamilton County Emergency Rental Assistance Program) are federal programs.

There are different rules for each program, but generally this chart can help you decide which program is best for you.



## PROGRAM DETAILS

**EAP** only covers utilities for the period of November 1 – May 16 of each year. If you have past due bills for other months, apply to HC ERAP.

Many utility programs require that you apply to **EAP** to qualify for their programs. If you have ongoing issues with utilities, apply to EAP.

Both programs have income limits to qualify.
