INDY SURVIVEOARS

The Indy SurviveOars (INSO), a nonprofit organization, is Central Indiana's only Breast Cancer Dragon Boat Team. The team was founded in 2007 and is in their sixteenth season!

The team has approximately 70 active paddlers ranging in ages from 33-76, who participate in 4-5 races per season, traveling throughout the Midwest, Canada, and Florida. The Indy SurviveOars team is noted for their unique team jerseys and paddles-symbolizing the greatest spectator sport-the Indianapolis 500! The Indy SurviveOars team serves as a physical support group for those affected by Breast Cancer. Some team members are in active treatment for their breast cancer and others longer survivors-but all continue to get healthy in their participation with the team. Indy SurviveOars mission is through the sport of dragon boat racing offers hope, inspiration and camaraderie to Breast Cancer survivors focusing on health and physical activity.

This April, the Indy SurviveOars travelled to New Zealand to participate in the IBCPC dragon boat festival.

HISTORY

The Indy SurviveOars (INSO) was the first dragon boat team of breast cancer survivors formed in the state of Indiana. The year was 2007, when Lisa Heiden Peters, a registered nurse and breast cancer survivor, had a dream of helping other survivors live their best lives. She had learned that the physical activity involved in the ancient sport of dragon boat racing improved the physical and mental condition of survivors. Peters envisioned a team — survivors, seated two abreast in the long, slender boats with a fierce dragon head leading the way, a drummer beating a cadence, guided deftly by a steer person - paddling their way in powerful unison to health

and to hope.

Dragon boat racing began more than 2,000 years ago in China and eventually made its way to North America in the 1980's. It is now the fastest growing team sport in the world. The sleek, skinny boats with a dragon head are propelled by 20 paddlers working in unison. The drummer beats out the pace and a steer person guides the 48 foot-long-boat on its course.

SAFESITTER CLASSES

In these classes, sitters will learn safety skills, such as preventing unsafe situations and learning how to deal with unexpected dangers like power outages. They will be taught life and business skills to help them screen jobs and discuss fees with potential employers. Also, they will learn first aid and rescue skills. including CPR and choking rescue. Lastly the class will include information on the ages and stages of child development and provide tips to help control sitter's behavior as well as the children's behavior.

SAFESITTER

Designed to prepare students in grades 6-8 to be safe when they're home alone, watching younger siblings, or babysitting.

The Instructor-led class is filled with fun games and role-playing exercises. Students even get to use manikins to practice rescue skills like choking rescue and CPR!
