Thank you again to Fishers City Barbeque for generously donating lunch and Fishers Police Officer, Dean Mucha, for being the speaker!














WANT TO DONATE?

They will purchase beef and dairy cattle and swine animals at the Hamilton County 4-H Livestock Auction which takes place on July 25, 2023. In the past seven years, 27,303 lbs of meat have been distributed to food pantries in Hamilton County and this meat has then provided the protein requirements for 109,212 meals!



Treehouse is an online platform for beginning and advanced users to learn various web development and programming skills.



What services are available?

The Heart and Soul Clinic is able to serve patients nonemergency dental needs by providing:

- Extractions
- Fillings
- Acute Dental Care



- Blood pressure/Blood sugar screenings
- Diagnosis and Treatment of Minor Illnesses
- Preventative Health Screenings and Education
- Women's Health Clinic
- Diabetes Education
- Sports, camp and work physicals
- Childhood Vaccinations

The Heart and Soul Clinic can also provide health referrals for free or low cost medical services as well as mental health services, such as Telehealth counseling.
