On Saturday, September 9th, 2023 Delaware Township Trustee's Office and Fall Creek Township Office were at Conner Prairie to unveil a marker that serves as a permanent Hamilton memorial of the Countv Bicentennial. This marker gives some history of Delaware and Fall Creek Townships and the land that Conner Prairie sits on today.

The Delaware Township side reads as follows:

"With the formation of Hamilton County in 1823, two townships were created - White River and Delaware. In 1833, these two areas were divided up into the current townships. The new Delaware Township extended west as far as present-day Rangeline Road. The town of Fishers was established in 1872. The township lost much of its area when the section west of White River split off to join Clay Township in 1955. However, by the 1990's, it had achieved a phenomenal amount of growth."

You can go see the marker at Conner Prairie outside of their balloon exhibit!

NEWCOMERS CLUB FISHERS

Newcomers Club is a social club for ladies, with over 90 members. The club began over 20 years ago as Welcome Wagon, but branched out to form their own organization. All ladies are welcome, not just those that are new to the area! There is a mix of newer residents and long-time residents from all over Hamilton County.

Newcomers Club makes contributions to give back to the community. The three main organizations they donate to are Come to Me Food Pantry at FUMC, Fishers Youth Assistance Program (Summer Meals Program), and Good Samaritan Network. They also make non-perishable food item donations to Delaware Township Food Pantry which serves HSE School District residents at their regular monthly meetings. Outside of the club, individual Newcomers' members volunteer at their local charitable organizations including; hospitals, libraries, cultural programs, the library, musical organizations, Conner Prairie, civic activities, the county fair, church groups, the Humane Society, and pet fostering.

When asked what her favorite part of being in the Newcomers Club is, Maribeth Pittman (Secretary of Newcomers Club) said, "My favorite part is the camaraderie, the sense of being a part of something very positive, a chance to share my time, energy, and skills with the group, and above all, the strong support that we give to one another. Each regular monthly meeting features a speaker and program/theme. Meetings are held from April - November. On occasion, there will be a field trip to a local place (ie. nursery) instead of a regular meeting.


HANDGUN SAFETY CLASS
