

DELAWARE TOWNSHIP'S 200TH BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION

History of Delaware Township


Delaware Township was established in 1823 bv the Hamilton County Commissioners, one of whom was William Conner. The meeting was held at the Conner home, where it was determined that the county would be subdivided into two townships - White River for the northern half and Delaware for the southern half. John Kirkendall appointed as the Delaware Township "Overseer of the Poor". His primary duty was to seek out those living in Delaware Township who were in need of basic necessities such as firewood, fuel, and food. This duty remains yet today with the Delaware Township Trustee.


